Both the Early Learning Years Framework (EYLF) and My Time Our Place (MTOP) outline principles, practices and learning outcomes that guide Educational leaders and Educators in their curriculum decision-making, and assist them in planning, delivering and evaluating quality programs in early childhood and school age settings. Following the release of the refreshed National Approved Learning Frameworks (ALF)

earlier this year, we are pleased to share two free virtual professional development sessions, as hosted by Kirsty Fantini, Early Years Training to help explore, understand and implement the updated EYLF v2 and MTOP v2.



We encourage you to explore, navigate and commence the transition to the updated ALF's v2 this year. It is through participating in sessions like these, by working with your Practice Mentor and by connecting in with other likeminded Educators that will help ensure a smooth and simple transition prior to the 1 February 2024, at which time the original EYLF and MTOP will cease to be recognised under the National Law.
